2011年12月12日,天晴。三十多位環保領袖生和中四級修讀生物科的同學參觀位於元朗米埔自然保護區。

米埔乃華南重要的保護區,是全港最大、國際最重要的拉姆薩爾濕地。隨團導師首先向同學講解濕地的形成、結構及重要性等。然後二人一組領取專業的觀鳥望遠鏡,進入保護區一窺全貌。

導師沿途講解所遇見的留鳥和候鳥的特徵和習性,並指出濕地多樣性的生態環境的重要。面對各式各樣的生物,同學難免滿腹疑團,導師很有耐性地解答同學的疑問。透過這活動,大家逐漸了解濕地生態的奇妙和對地球環境的貢獻。當天所看到的鳥類多不勝數,有大自鸞、小白鷺、蒼鷺、黑尾蠟嘴雀、白腹海鵰、黑嘴鷗等。可惜我們未能一睹冬季候鳥的代言人——黑臉琵鷺的風采。

好戲在後頭,同學再分成3組,於濕地內不同地點收集水板,並在實驗室透過各項儀器 分析水質。當大家從顯微鏡觀察到原本清澈的湖水,原來蘊藏不少奇特的微 生物時,都興奮莫名。

最後,導師總結了我們當天所獲得的濕地生態知識。回程前,老師買了一個既環保又創意十足的文具:無釘釘書機。這釘書機無需使用釘書釘,便能把數頁紙緊緊扣在一起。同學都讚歎環境保護工作者的心思和創意。

你明白失明人士的世界嗎?本校公益 少年團和融合教育組於1月9日舉辦了「黑 暗中對話」體驗活動。約30名學生前往美 写「黑暗中對話」體驗館,親身感受失明 人士的日常生活所面對的挑戰。

體驗館設街市、渡輪、馬路、公園等佈置來模擬真實場面。同學只能靠視覺以外的感官來感受各場景獨特的景緻、聲音、氣味,甚至味道。視障導賞員引導同學在黑暗裡善用視覺以下的感官來探索四周環境,從而了解失明人士如何克服生活上的困難。

because he could make friends with the primary school students. He found it interesting to express his feelings in writing.


Language Across Curriculum (LAC) Book Fair


The characters in the drama "East meets West" were funny. They were lively and they sang very well. The drama highlighted the special features of Hong Kong culture, such as language and food.




地理考察血红色


實地考察是地理科的特色,對學習地理十分重要。以下是最近中五至中七級的地理考察活動:
